

Daniel 12:1-13 Sealed Until the End

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Dan 12:1 NKJV - "At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands [watch] over the sons of your people; And there shall be a time of trouble, Such as never was since there was a nation, [Even] to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, Every one who is found written in the book.

Rev 12:7 NKJV - And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought,

Isa 26:20 NKJV - Come, my people, enter your chambers, And shut your doors behind you; Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, Until the indignation is past.

Isa 26:21 NKJV - For behold, the LORD comes out of His place To punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; The earth will also disclose her blood, And will no more cover her slain.

Jer 30:7 NKJV - Alas! For that day [is] great, So that none [is] like it; **And it [is] the time of Jacob's trouble**, But he shall be saved out of it.

Mat 24:21 NKJV - "For then there will be **great tribulation**, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Dan 12:2 NKJV - And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, Some to everlasting life, Some to shame [and] everlasting contempt.

Speaking of the resurrections.. But Daniel not differentiating between the first and the second or the timeframe that was later revealed.

First Resurrection:

Rev 20:4 NKJV - And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then [I saw] the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received [his] mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 NKJV - **But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished.** This [is] the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 NKJV - Blessed and holy [is] he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

Second Resurrection:

Rev 20:11 NKJV - Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 NKJV - And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is [the Book] of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

Rev 20:13 NKJV - The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

Rev 20:14 NKJV - Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 20:15 NKJV - And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

Dan 12:3 NKJV - Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.

Dan 12:4 NKJV - "But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase."

Dan 12:5 NKJV - Then I, Daniel, looked; and there stood two others, one on this riverbank and the other on that riverbank.

Dan 12:6 NKJV - And [one] said to the man clothed in linen, who [was] above the waters of the river, "How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders [be]?"

NLT: One of them asked the man dressed in linen, who was now standing above the river, "How long will it be until these shocking events are over?"

Dan 12:7 NKJV - Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who [was] above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that **[it shall be] for a time, times, and half [a time]**; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these [things] shall be finished.

Dan 7:25 NKJV - He shall speak [pompous] words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High, And shall intend to change times and law. Then [the saints] shall be given into his hand **For a time and times and half a time.**

Dan 7:26 NKJV - 'But the court shall be seated, And they shall take away his dominion, To consume and destroy [it] forever.

Dan 7:27 NKJV - Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom [is] an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'

Dan 12:8 NKJV - Although I heard, I did not understand. Then I said, "My lord, what [shall be] the end of these [things]?"

Dan 12:9 NKJV - And he said, "Go [your way], Daniel, for the words [are] closed up and sealed till the time of the end.

Dan 12:10 NKJV - "Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.

Dan 12:11 NKJV - "And from the time [that] the daily [sacrifice] is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, **[there shall be] one thousand two hundred and ninety days.**

Dan 12:12 NKJV - "Blessed [is] he who waits, and comes to the **one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days.**

Dan 12:13 NKJV - "But you, go [your way] till the end; for you shall rest, and will arise to your inheritance at the end of the days."

Explanation from the UCG Bible Commentary:

*In verse 11, Daniel is specifically told that the time from the taking away of daily sacrifices and the setting up of the end-time abomination of desolation would be 1,290 days. Verse 12 then mentions an enigmatic 1,335 days. The key to understanding appears to be verse 13, where Daniel is told that he will rise to his inheritance "at the end of the days." This seems to mean the end of the various groupings of days mentioned. That is, the three and a half years (1,260 days), the 1,290 days and the 1,335 days all seem to end at the time Daniel is resurrected at Christ's return. A **possible** scenario is that breaking of the power of the saints—the cutting off of their public preaching—will come 1,335 days before Christ's return. Then, 45 days later, 1,290 days before Christ's return, the abomination of desolation will be set up. And then, 30 days later, 1,260 days before Christ's return, the Great Tribulation will commence. Thankfully, Christ will return in just three and a half years from this point to bring deliverance to the people of Israel and Judah (as the commencement of His deliverance of all mankind) and everlasting life to his saints. The dead in Christ will live again.*
